Opinion

We have audited the accompanying annual financial results of **UR SUGAR INDUSTRIES LTD (Formerly HKG LIMITED)** (the "Company") for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2025 attached herewith, being prepared and submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended (the "Listing Regulation").
